	ICARO recommends having wings that are often used for training of descent exercises, acrobatics or flying in salty or sandy conditions subjected to check ups all 100 operating hours or 12 month . It is also important, to consider ground handling hours. All gliders, especially gliders manufactured with light and thin material are mechanically more stressed than other gliders. Therefore ICARO recommends multiplying ground handling hours with the factor 1, 5.
